Tamaskan Rescue

As you may have already heard, Tamaskan Rescue is now a sub-committee of the TDR, so that they may better leverage the resources available through the TDR to help Tamaskan Dogs in need. They will continue to operate as they always have, and essentially be independent of any other TDR projects or efforts. Tamaskan Rescue would like to emphasize that they seek to help all Tamaskan Dogs internationally, regardless of registry. Their announcement is as follows:



The Tamaskan Rescue, a small nonprofit set with the goal to assess in rescuing and rehoming Tamaskan Dogs internationally, has been added as a sub committee to the Tamaskan Dog Register.

While originally a non-profit in its own right, due to the lack of volunteers, resources, and reach as a singular organization, Tamaskan Rescue has chosen to join efforts with this established club in order to continue to operate with its original goals, intent, and continue to support the breed it loves. This change will allow for cleaner operations, improvements, the ability to accept donations, better assist breeders and the community as a whole, and make it easier in turn for the community to safeguard the dogs we have all come together to care for and love.
